

Donate your spare mobile phone and help CARE save lives!!



CARE and CollectiveGood have developed a major mobile phone recycling initiative, designed to capture idle mobile phones in North America and re-deploy them back into reuse in Latin America, solving an environmental problem, raising life saving funds for CARE, and bridging the digital divide in Latin America. The program solves the dilemma that so many mobile phone users face: What do I do with this extra cell phone? Proceeds from the sale of these phones will be used by CARE to further their aid and development work on a global scale, essentially converting idle mobile phones into food, clean water, medicine and educational programs throughout the developing world. Participants will receive a donation acknowledgement and thank-you letter to use for tax purposes.

Donating your phone also helps preserve the environment by keeping them out of our landfills – mobile phones contain toxic materials such as Cadmium, Lead, Mercury and Galium Arsenide. Your donated phone will be recycled back into reuse, usually in the developing world. Please fill out and attach the form below to your donated phone(s) before mailing in:
