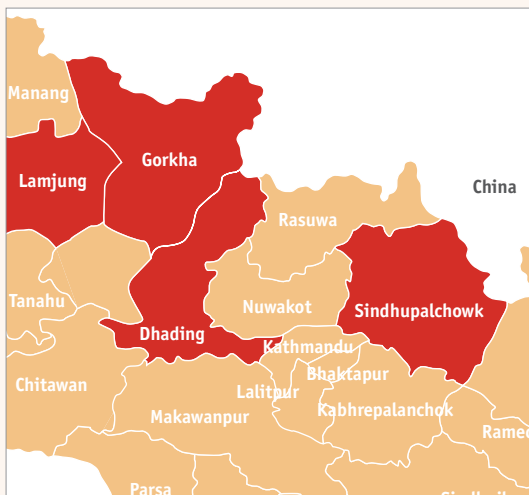

IN OVER 80 YEARS.**

On **April 25** and **May 12** 2015 Nepal was rocked by two devastating 7.8 and 7.3 magnitude earthquakes.

The 3 month long **MONSOON** season has started across Nepal, making many areas **INACCESSIBLE** and increasing the risk of **LANDSLIDES** and potential for further casualties and destruction.

Many affected areas are extremely remote, having no road access even in normal circumstances and many of the previously usable roads are now cut off by landslides.

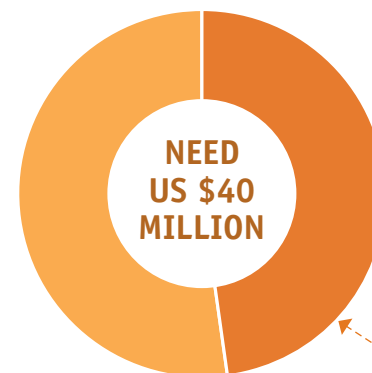
