On April 25 and May 12 2015 Nepal was rocked by two devastating 7.8 and 7.3 magnitude earthquakes.

The 3 month long **MONSOON** season has started across Nepal, making many areas INACESSIBLE and increasing the risk of LANDSLIDES and potential for further casualties and destruction.

Many affected areas are extremely remote, having no road access even in normal circumstances and many of the previously usable roads are now cut off by landslides.


SAFE DEMOLITION ASSISTANCE

14,000 WOMEN ARE EXPECTED TO GIVE BIRTH IN THE NEXT MONTH.
