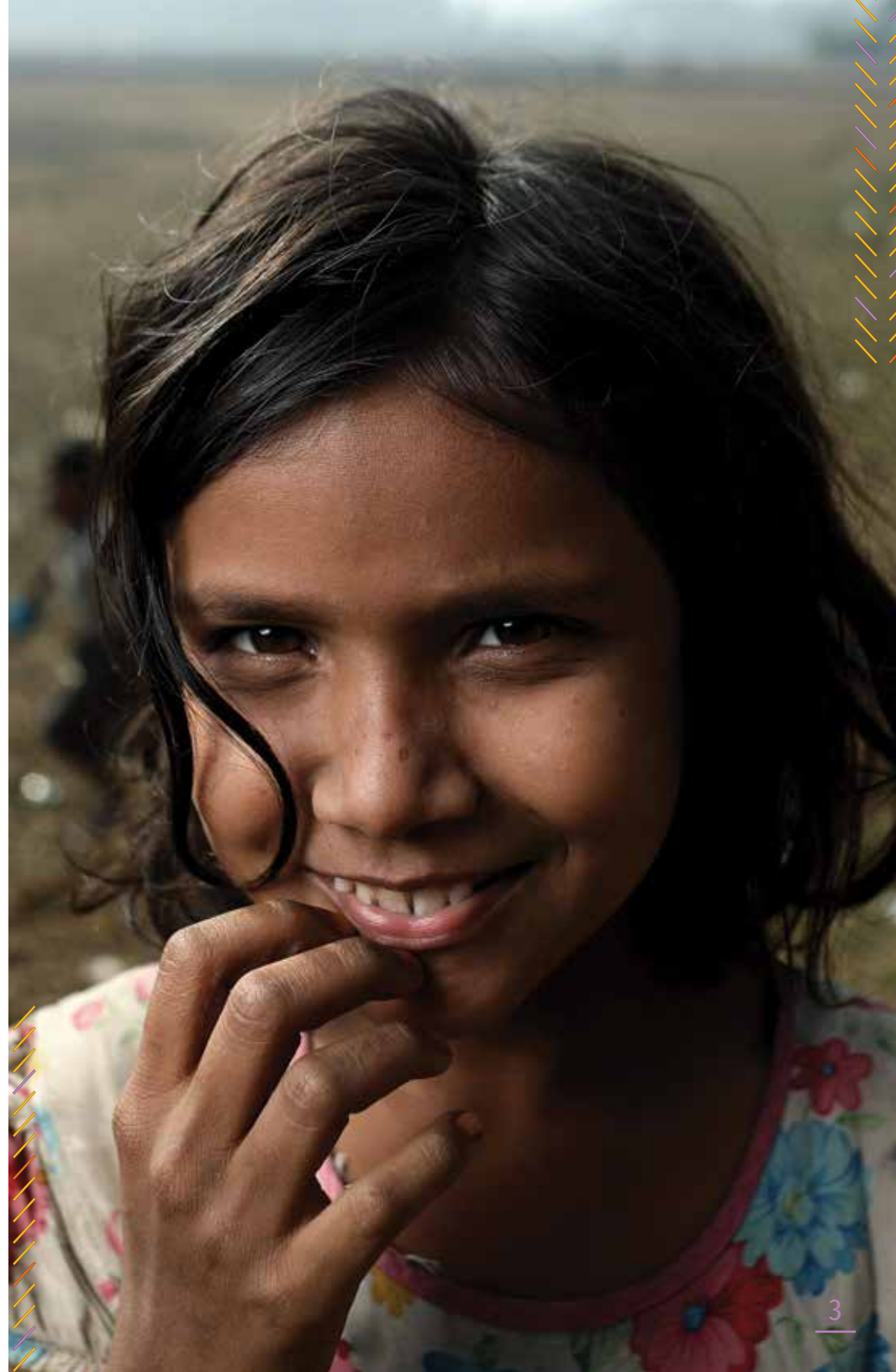

## CARE CRISIS RESPONSE CAMPAIGN



COVID-19 RESPONSE,  
VACCINATION AND ECONOMIC  
RECOVERY EFFORTS SHOULD  
LEAVE NO ONE BEHIND

CARE's response to COVID-19 is the largest in our history. While the COVID-19 vaccines have brought new hope, the danger is far from over—too many are going hungry, too many families lack access to clean water, and too many girls are losing access to education.

To counter these challenges, we launched the **Crisis Response Campaign**, and have raised \$100 million toward our updated goal of \$150 million and directly reached 47.5 million people in 69 countries. A continued investment right now allows us to rapidly respond to changing global humanitarian conditions and helps prevent a devastating reversal of hard-won development gains. Our response remains focused on:

- **Saving and protecting lives** by providing clean water and hygiene to combat the virus, and emergency food to prevent hunger and malnutrition.
- **Building resilient communities** by harnessing the power of women entrepreneurs and farmers as the key to recovery through our proven, scalable programs.
- **Defeating the virus** by ensuring equitable distribution of vaccines and strengthening primary healthcare systems.

With 75 years of leadership and a local presence in 100 countries, CARE has the community roots necessary to lead an effective response to the COVID-19 crisis. Investing in women and girls' leadership is the key to global recovery, and with your partnership, we all stand alongside them to build a stronger, more equitable, and secure future for everyone.

## CARE BY THE NUMBERS 2020

**28.8M** people reached through humanitarian response.

**39%** of all projects tested new ways to fight poverty.

**22.6M** people supported as they increased their food security and resilience to climate change.

**2.4M** people helped to live a life free from violence.

**44%** of projects engaged in advocacy.

**33.8M** people equipped with information and access to sexual, reproductive, and maternal health resources.

**2.6M** women economically empowered by expanding access to financial services, employment, and equitable wages.

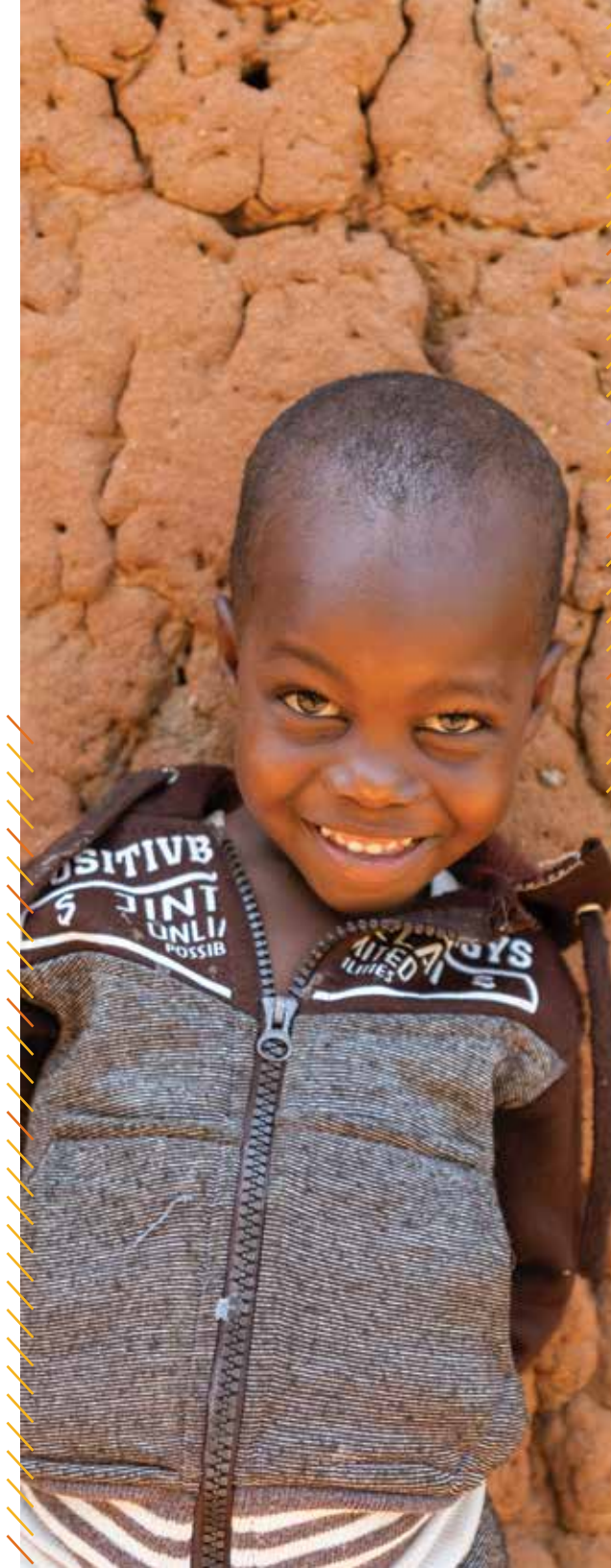

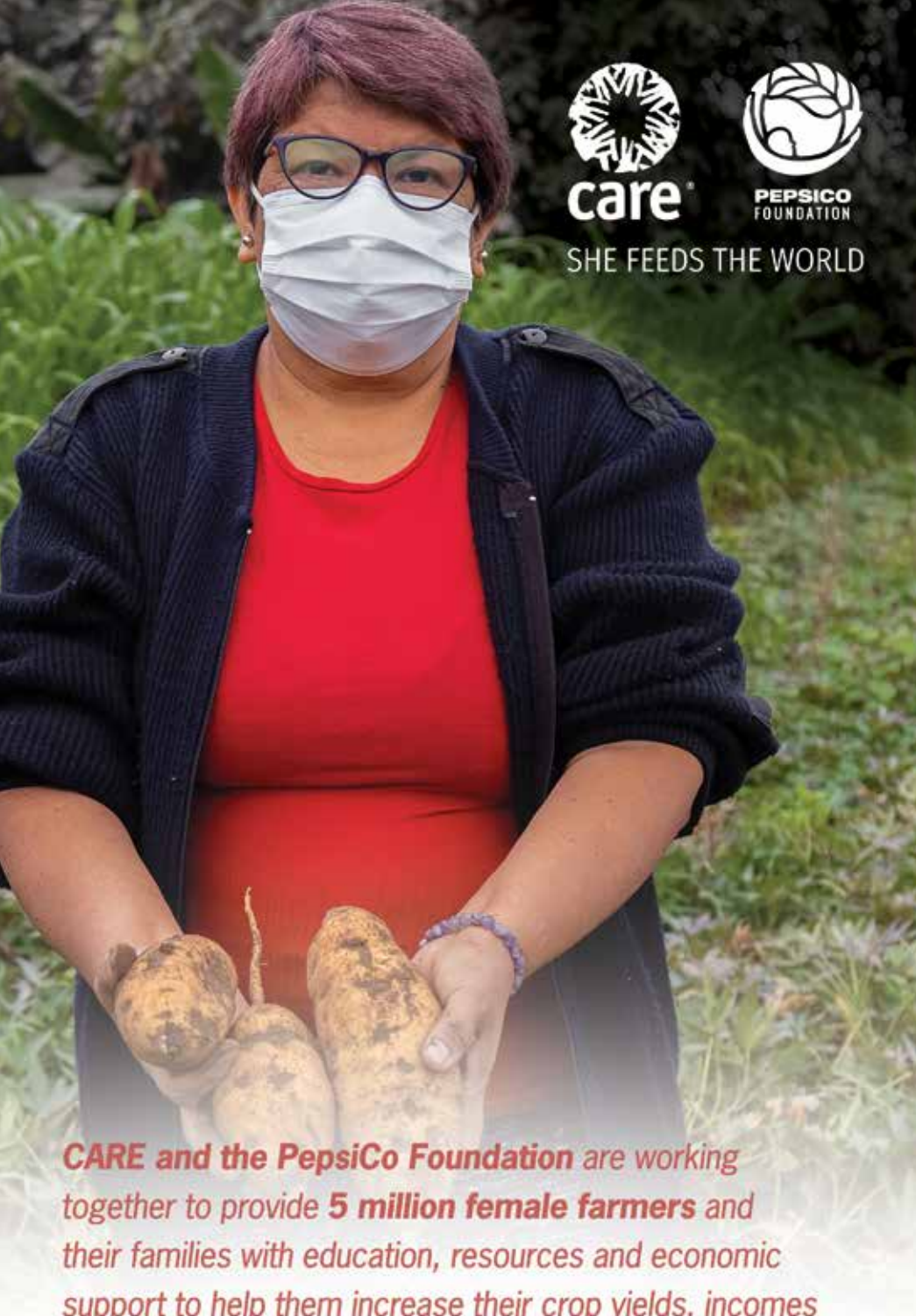

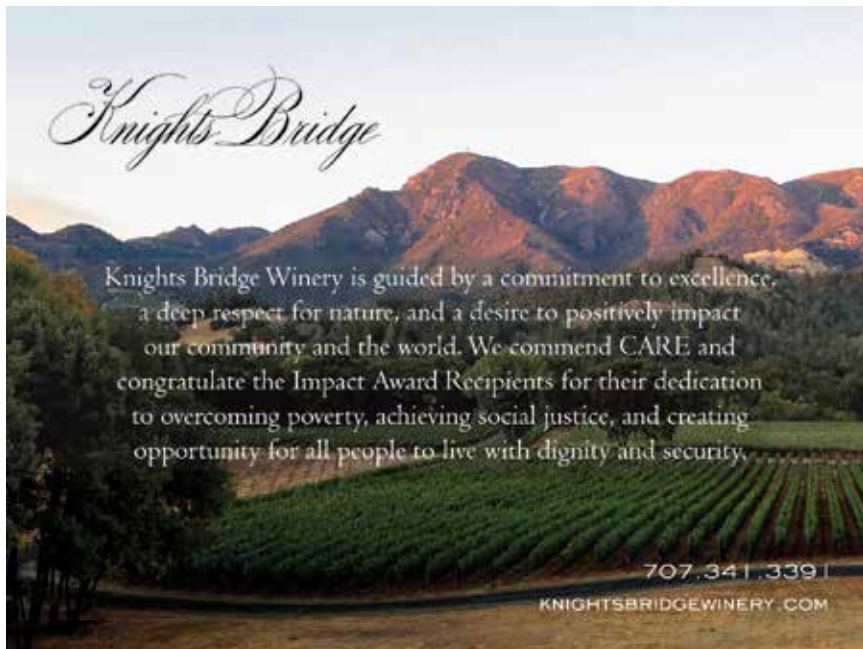
