Overview

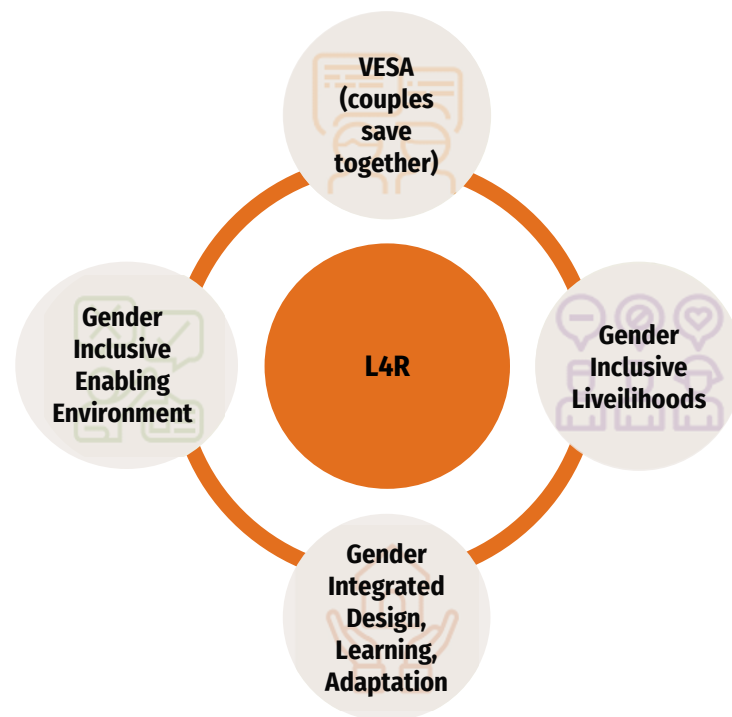
The Livelihoods for Resilience project worked with VESA members (husbands and wives) to graduate households into food security and sustainable income generating livelihoods.

Results

Women account for **43% of project clients** engaged in value chains (producing on a more “commercial” level)

Women and men participate in livelihoods activities together.

Over **1,300 women** are engaged as micro-franchise saleswomen



31,000

More women participating in the program than the 97,000 anticipated by the program

48%

Loans received by women from MFIs facilitated by the project
