

Respond. Sustain. Rise

In 2025, CARE's programs reached 58.7 million people worldwide, 57% of whom were women and girls. Despite sudden cuts in U.S. and global funding in a challenging environment, CARE continued to meet urgent needs while supporting long-term stability and economic opportunity so families can build stronger futures.

From crisis zones to rural farms to busy urban markets, CARE works alongside communities through approaches led by local experience and knowledge. In Myanmar, when a 7.7-magnitude earthquake struck, local leaders like longtime volunteer Mai mobilized quickly — showing how community-led action saves lives and helps families begin to recover.

In Yemen's Taiz Governorate, women farmers like Bushra are growing food and income through seeds, tools, irrigation support, and hands-on training offered close to home. Their home gardens are helping families access nutritious food, support children's education, and strengthen community ties.

In Uganda, refugee and savings-group leader Mwilalimbaya Mbo shows how access to financial tools can open doors. With digital savings records and new connections to lenders, she and other women have secured capital to start small businesses and support their families — strengthening local markets in the process.

CARE's impact in 2025 is reflected not only in the numbers but in the people leading change in their own communities. Their stories show how CARE helps communities respond to crisis, sustain progress, and rise to meet new opportunities.
